Helping in the Café



The café is currently open from 10.00 to 12.00 Monday to Friday. Join the team to provide tea, coffee, cakes and maybe a chat. We plan to open it some afternoons and Saturday mornings. Full training given.

Helping in the Licensed Bar

The Bar is open for most evening events in the Centre, and helpers work in pairs for larger events. A rota allows for individual selection, training is given and hours vary.



Join the Technical Team



Help the team provide sound, lighting and audio-visual support to events in the Centre. It would help if you had a technical background but training will be given. Hours vary.

Assist in the Charity Shop

The Village Charity Shop on the Green is run by the Centre and raises revenue for it. The shop is open Monday – Saturday from 11am to 4pm. Volunteers work in pairs – flexible days, two-hour shifts – and training is given. Also cover special sales events in the Centre.

The “Bovols” are the volunteers who look after the Box Office selling tickets for events at the Centre. A computer-based system is used and training is given. The Box Office is open from 10am to 4pm Monday to Friday.
